

Scuba Programs offered at Camp Workcoeman

Discover SCUBA

(Wednesdays, 2:00 – 4:00 pm, costs \$50):

The Discover SCUBA program allows scouts who have no previous SCUBA diving experience to participate in an underwater diving program. Many participants are first time divers. All necessary equipment is provided. Scouts learn basics about how to wear and use diving equipment, and spend approximately 30-45 minutes underwater with their instructor. All participants must be blue-tag swimmers.



PADI Certification Course

(offered during Week 3, costs \$450):

Scouts spend an entire week at camp devoted to becoming PADI certified SCUBA divers. Three hour sessions in the morning and afternoon are held each day Monday through Friday. Students will complete both classroom requirements and gain practical dive experience. There is no age requirement; however scouts under the age of 16 are only eligible to earn a Junior Diver certification through PADI. Scouts who complete all requirements throughout the week can also earn the Scuba Diving Merit Badge.



Additional PADI certifications available to Scouts:

For scouts who have previously participated in the week long PADI certification course at Camp Workcoeman, or who have otherwise previously earned their certification, a variety of advanced courses can be run with our dive instructors.

- ~ Underwater Naturalist
