## Emergency & Medical Services Camp

Experience what it's like to be blind and/or disabled. Learn about careers in the medical field. Find out how to keep the public safe from bacteria. Is it true that a dog with a wet nose is healthy? Participate in a camp-wide search and rescue; learn fire safety, first aid, and experience emergency vehicles. Merit badges offered include: ***Crime Prevention, Dentistry, Disability Awareness, Fire Safety, First Aid, Medicine, Public Health, Search & Rescue, Fingerprinting and Veterinary Medicine.***



## Trail To Eagle Camp

The Trail to Eagle (T2E) Program is designed for the Scout who has set his goal on reaching the rank of Eagle Scout. It is a unique camping and advancement opportunity to work on Eagle required badges. Guidance on how to select, plan and complete your Eagle Service Project will be featured during the week. All Scouts are placed in a "Trail to Eagle" troop with an experienced staff member as the T2E Scoutmaster. The T2E Camp is open to all Scouts who have earned the First Class rank.



## Shooting Sports Camp

This is not a typical week of camp. It is a special week where Scouts will concentrate on all shooting sports - .22 Rifle Shooting - Shotgun Shooting - Archery Merit Badges- Muzzleloading and Tomahawks. Scouts will also have the opportunity to earn a series of NRA Marksmanship Awards. Scouts age 14+ will also participate in the BSA Pistol Shooting Program. Scouts will also participate in a special flyfishing adventure on the Farmington River - BIG FUN !

## Workcoeman Wilderness Experience

Spend a week in the wilderness of Camp Workcoeman putting to use those Scoutcraft skills. Scouts will visit the Shawtown settlement and work on ***Archeology, Forestry and Wilderness Survival Merit Badges*** all while learning how to build a Mahoosuc wilderness shelter. The program will include an advancement component, a skill component, and a backpacking component. Other activities will include black powder shooting and tomahawk throwing as part of a pioneer experience!



## Aquatics Camp

**New for 2016!** This program focuses on all of the aquatic merit badges, awards and all related certifications. The week is completely dedicated to swimming and watercraft skills. Participants will experience Workcoeman's vast sailing fleet as well as scuba and other exciting experiences both in and out of camp. Space is limited so sign up early.



## PADI Scuba Certification

Scouts spend an entire week at camp devoted to becoming a PADI certified scuba diver. Scouts who complete all requirements throughout the week will also earn the *Scuba Diving Merit Badge*. There is no age requirement; however Scouts under the age of 16 are only eligible to earn a PADI Junior Diver certification. Scouts with current PADI certification can expand their diving experience by earning additional certifications such as: Digital Underwater Photographer, Underwater Naturalist, and Advanced Open Water Diver.
